## HIGHLIGHTS

- EMS Billing began on August 26. There will be an ongoing learning curve as we go along and we strive to work any issues out with the billing company.
- In conjunction with EMS Billing, HIPPA Training and the establishment of a Privacy Officer wo will handle billing, privacy and report requests was instituted. Lt Brian Niemet will handle these responsibilities along with assuring the reports are uploaded to the billing company for processing.
- The new Engine 321 arrived and was placed in-service.
- The department received the 2019 changing the Odds Award from the United Way of Delaware County. This award was given to the department bed brigade for their work to assure that children without beds have one. This project has been organized by FF Sean Worley and has been in existence for the past 5 years.
- Fire Prevention conducted a total of 54 inspections with 68 violations noted. They reviewed 10 plans for new or renovation projects, collecting \$3175.00 in fees and permits.
