

OPERATIONS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Sept. 17, 2019 | 6:30 p.m. City of Powell Municipal Building Council Chambers | 47 Hall Street

Attendance: Councilmember Brendan Newcomb, Melissa Riggins, Daniel Swartwout and Jon Bennehoof; Citizen Representative Heather Gonzalez and Ryan Herchenroether; City Manager Steve Lutz, Chief of Police Stephen Hrytzik, Development Director David Betz, City Engineer Chris Huber, Communications Director Megan Canavan and Legal Counsel Thaddeus Boggs; and other interested parties.

I. <u>APPROVAL OF AUGUST 20, 2019 MEETING MINUTES</u> The minutes were approved.

II. PROPOSED MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENT REGULATIONS

Legal counsel provided an overview of the proposed legislation. Thaddeus Boggs provided an update regarding the language of the ordinance. Committee members provided feedback and revisions.

ACTION ITEM: The Committee would like to hold a public meeting with massage establishments in Powell to discuss the proposed ordinance and gather feedback.

III. COMMUNITY RENTAL ROOM POLICY REVIEW

Councilmember Brian Lorenz asked the Committee to review the community room rental policy. City Manager Steve Lutz provided an overview of the policy and why it was created 10-12 years ago.

ACTION ITEM: The Committee will discuss this item further during the next meeting. Staff will generate a report to see the list of rentals in 2018-2019.

IV. MOVING 25 MPH SIGNS ON OLENTANGY STREET

Councilmember Brendan Newcomb discussed whether or not the 25 MPH signs should be relocated along Olentangy Street. City Engineer Chris Huber provided a map of where the signs are located along the street. He also indicated the City would need to conduct a traffic study to review this roadway to study the characteristic of the road. The results and recommendations from the study would need to be sent to the Ohio Department of Transportation because of this being a state route.

ACTION ITEM: The Committee requested that the Engineering Department gather data on next steps (e.g. speed study, etc.) and how this can be implemented.

V. BICYCLE FRIENDLY COMMUNITY DISCUSSION

This item has been moved to the Development Committee.

VI. POWELL STREET MARKET LOCATION CHANGE

The City received positive feedback about the location of the Street Market.
