

ORDINANCE 2020-18 Adopted September 1, 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A BID TO CARGILL CORPORATION FOR HIGHWAY ROCK SALT.

WHEREAS, the City has participated in a co-operative bidding process for highway rock salt; and

Council and Staff recommend Cargill Corporation as the lowest and best bidder WHEREAS, for the above-mentioned item.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAW ARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

That Council hereby awards the bid for highway rock salt to Cargill Corporation Section 1: and authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City for the purpose of purchasing highway rock salt for the 2020-2021 winter season.

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council Section 2: concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.
